

Firrhill Rights Respecting Schools Award – Journey to Level 1



The Firrhill Rights Respecting Schools pupil and staff groups have been very busy over the past few months and we are pleased to announce that we have gained the Recognition of Commitment Award!

The Recognition of Commitment Award (RoC) involved establishing a pupil and staff committee, making parents aware through Parent Council, a pupil and staff audit and putting forward an action plan towards the Level 1 Award.

Level 1 charts Firrhill's progress through 4 Standards of the Award, which relate to leadership, learning about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), having a rights-respecting ethos and young people being involved in citizenship activities.

Here is a snapshot of some of our work towards the plan so far:

Pupil house assemblies – launching the start of our journey to level 1

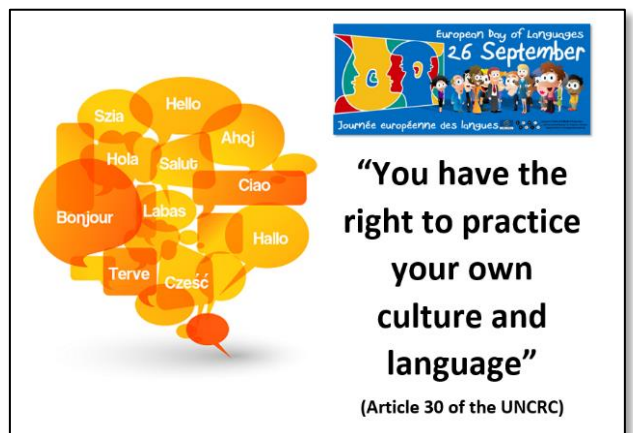
Staff and pupil termly updates

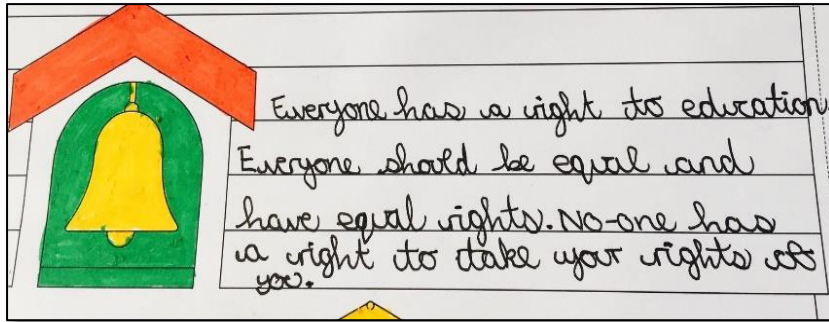
Took part in UNICEF's Day for Change
