SI-3 BGE HISTORY

Through the BGE, our students develop the skills required to be an excellent historian. Studying the history of Edinburgh, the horrors of the Atlantic Slave Trade and the outbreak and nature of WW2, our SIs and S2s experience a varied and exciting curriculum. This builds to S3 where we study Scotland in the Era of the Great War, building both skills and content at N5 level in preparation for the senior phase. Our S3 pupils also have the opportunity to achieve N4 Classical Studies as part of their skills rotation.

SI-3 BGE GEOGRAPHY

In SI Geography, pupils develop their map skills, investigate climate regions such as deserts, rainforests and the tundra plus undertake a case study on life in China. In S2, pupils will find out how earthquakes, volcanoes and tsunamis are created and what damage they can cause. Furthermore, during this year pupils will also explore the UN's Global Goals with lessons on malaria and ocean plastic. In S3 pupils complete a case study on Rio de Janeiro, study the formation of rivers, research how climate change is affecting the world and compare farming in the UK and India. Furthermore, in S3 pupils will have the chance to study N4 Travel and Tourism as part of the skills rotation.
