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September 2023 update: Working towards the launch of a new parental engagment strategy in May/June '24

Aims of Strategy:

- 1. To improve pupil outcomes in the broadest sense (attainment, achievement, health and wellbeing)
- 2. To increase parents' self confidence in supporting learning at home (self efficacy)
- 3. To increase opportunities for parents to work together (social capital)

This year we are piloting 6 key activity areas in line with our aims:

"Parental Engagement that has the strongest relationship with attainment includes displaying enthusiasm for learning, encouraging good study habits" (Hattie, 2008)
